#### **FEMA**

992 residents have registered for assistance  
55 families are living in travel trailers (temporary)  
Developing Long Term Mobile Home Park

#### **Camp Noah** – Lutheran Social Service

For children recovering from a disaster  
Children who have relocated to other towns are also eligible  
Hours are 9-3 for 5 afternoons  
Location is yet to be determined  
Exploring possibility of sending older children to existing summer camp

#### **Still in need of:**

Camp Counselors  
Mental Health – possibly school counselors  
Location  
Need to determine if school supplies can be distributed from the camp or if schools are planning on providing back pack with school supplies to students

### **Notes from City Hall Meeting**

75% of debris has been cleaned up  
School will start in August in temporary trailers  
People are responsible for paying the deposit and any outstanding fees for utilities  
City is replanning the Business District to include the “Big Well”  
Possibly be rerouting Hwy 54  
All building permits are \$35  
Building from N Illinois Ave. and in the general downtown square area are suspended for 2 wks  
Single Wide trailers are not allowed on property sites  
Double Wide trailers are allowed if the under carriage is removed and trailer is placed directly on foundation  
1<sup>st</sup> of August is anticipated date of first move-ins
