Building

- The contract was signed for the houses out of Wichita, and the down payment was made. The units are scheduled to be in Greensburg by October 15th. There is also the potential for 2 more houses to come out

of Larned. James and Matt will be setting up a time to go look at these. The cost estimate for refurbishing these houses is between \$15,000-\$20,000, bringing the total cost of homes to around \$45,000

- SCKTRO started its 4th new construction on Monday, October 1st. Basement is being poured today!

Melvin stated that he can get a crew to help repair if these funds can be obtained. Debbie Snapp from Catholic Social Services stated that she will have one of her social workers contact Marcia to see if they can help.
- Matt has learned of a 1986 Ford 250xl 15 passenger van that was traded in Dodge City. The estimated cost of this van is between \$4,500 and \$5,000. Matt believes that this would be a good tool for transporting volunteers around Greensburg now that the weather is getting cooler.
